8. Declarations of Pecuniary Interest:

9. Jubilee Big Lunch:

- a. Members conducted a post event review of the Big Jubilee Lunch. It was established that;

The Clerk advised members that the Full Council had already agreed to allow voluntary groups to supply teas and coffees from the pavilion in order to funds for their groups. This item was therefore withdrawn.

- b. Members were asked to consider financial support to assist any start up. The Clerk advised members that the Council had already provided mugs, teapots, water jugs, plastic tumblers a large water urn and tea towels at the Pavilion for such a situation. Members decided that no further financial support was necessary.
